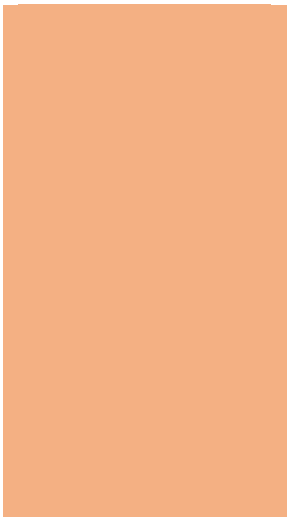

1st Kick-off Meeting – Santiago de Compostela. October 17th and 18th 2019

The project coordinator introduced the main aims and expected products of the project, as it is in the project application.

Partners shared ideas about it and agreed in the importance of involving young people in the development of project activities from the very beginning, in order to be sure that the project results totally fits with needs of youngster in secondary education and, at the same time, to include their contributions in the project, mainly by involving them in field activities carried out around the rivers.

Consortium partners decided that the products will be developed using a cross approach. Regarding the technical approach consortium agreed on including different resources and methodologies, depending on the particular requirements of each topic: narrative, stories, animations, texts...

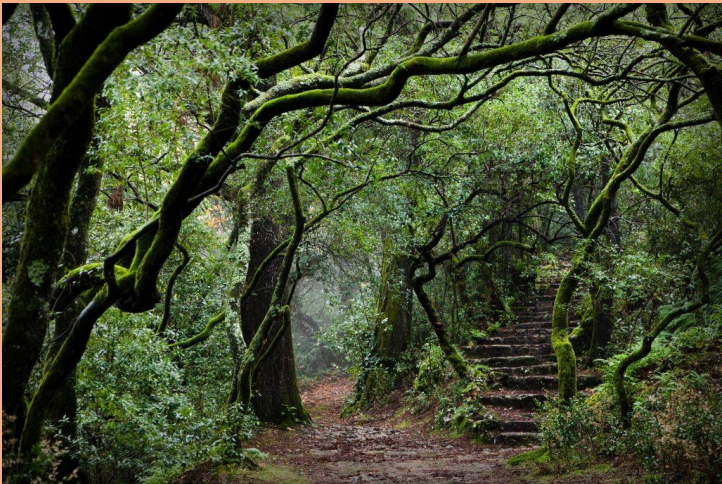
Agentia Metropolitana Pentru Dezvoltare Durabila Brasov Asociatia – Romania

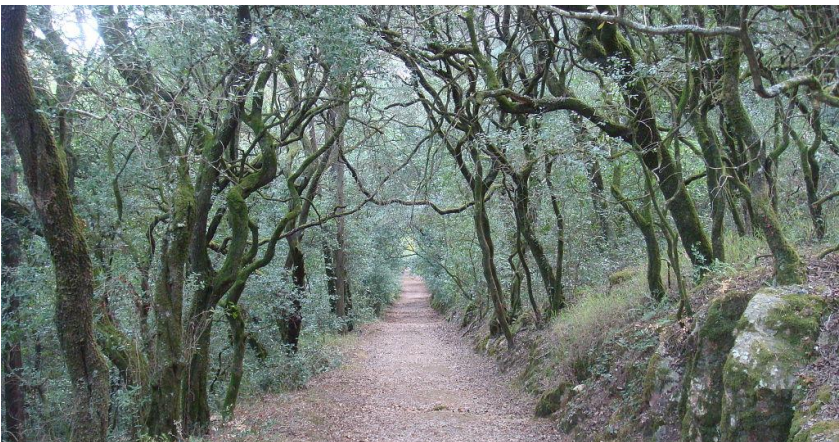
Høgskulen for grøn utvikling (HGUt) – Norway
